



IndyGo Bus Safety Training

What If I am lost?

- Ask the bus driver for help (bus number & direction headed)
- Stay on the bus! (safe place)
- Call someone to help:
EC (Job Coach), trainer home, family member
- After you call someone, ask the driver take you to a familiar place along the bus route

What if I get on the wrong bus?

- Talk to the bus driver
- Stay on the bus! (safe place)
- Call someone to help:
EC (Job Coach), trainer, home, family member
- When possible, get off at the bus stop where you got on the wrong bus

What if I get off at the wrong bus stop?

- Look at street signs, the IndyGO bus sign, buildings, churches, businesses, stores and restaurants
- Look for a safe place (fire station, police station, library, store, open business with people)
- Tell someone in the safe place that you got off the bus at the wrong stop & ask to use a phone
- Call someone to help:
EC (Job Coach), trainer, home, family member

Skills I need to have:

- Know how to call for help:
EC (Job Coach), trainer, home, family member
- Know how to ask for help calling someone if I do not have cell phone
- Keep a list of phone numbers with me at all times
- Know my bus number
- Know my bus stop street name(s).
- Have both a State-issued ID & an IndyGO ID (school ID for student)
